Seal of Approval Contract



In order to process your application for the Lab Tested Mom Approved™ Seal of Approval:

- Please send a small sample of the product by mail along with this application to:
PFWBS Testing Committee 3901 Oak Crest Drive, Barnhart, Missouri 63012.
Products will require re-test every 3 years.
- An additional sample must be sent to Bureau Veritas Lab to test against our criteria. A passing lab sheet is required for the seal to be used in the USA and in Canada.
- Name Parents for Window Blind Safety as an additional insured on your policy after approval on product. Please send us a copy of your policy, annually. Products sold in Canada must also be covered in Canada.
- To cover the costs of the product assessment, there is a \$300 fee for this service. Assessments take place in-house with our Testing Committee who incorporate design verification, document review, and quality plans to ensure ongoing compliance with approved products. This is a non-refundable fee. Payments via Payal, wire transfer or checks are accepted. Checks should be made payable to:

FEES:

Upon the Testing Lab approval, an annual marketing fee of \$1200 *per product design category* for the use in United States or Canada and must be received before placing the seal on marketing materials and packaging. Manufactures seeking dual use in Canada and the USA will receive a discounted fee of \$1700 per product category. Cost is per product design depending on materials used. See attached list of product design categories. Authorization letters cannot be mailed until fees have been reconciled. Annual invoices will be sent prior to the expiration of seal unless payment plan has been established.

Contracts will be renewed annually, and are subject to an increase of up to 2% each year. Contracts are considered void if any changes are made to the product after the product has been tested and approved.

The Parents for Window Blind Safety Testing Committee will issue a formal authorization to manufactures of products that meet the criteria. The use of the seal is strictly prohibited until authorization document has been granted.
